PARTS - EDIT PART DEFINITION YIELD CONFIG


A part definition's **Yield Config** details may need to be edited after having been added and saved to the system.

Accurate information helps to manage yield and service charges effectively.


Ribbon Select Inventory > Parts




- The **Part Listing** screen will be displayed.
- Select the **row** of the part definition where you wish to make changes to the **Yield Config** details.
- Click on **Edit**.



- The **Edit Part - []** screen will open.
- Move further down the right hand side of the **Edit Part - []** screen to the **Yield Config** panel.
- In the **Yield Config** panel you can see that the **Yield** is set at 5000 copies. This is how many prints can be generated.



- In this example, the **Yield** value for the part definition has been adjusted to reflect 8000 copies.
- When you have made all the required changes to the **Yield Config** panel, click on **Save**.



- Your changes will be saved and you will return to the **Part Listing** screen.
