#### Modifications:

 DBN0127592: PostAR transactions, posted from the primary Evo database to a secondary Evo database, were incorrectly using the customer's dclink code from the primary Evo Database instead of from the secondary Evo database for the LinkACCcode field.

MultiEvoRePostingEngine v1.0.0.6 (Mods):

 DBN0116463: It was found that SINV transactions with a related SIBB sub-transaction were not being flagged as processed in tbIACCTSyncQueue, causing the SIBB transactions to be processed more than once.

MultiEvoRePostingEngine v1.0.0.5 (Mods):



- DBN0105479: A change was required to look up customer and supplier IDs based on codes in the site EVO databases when posting transactions; and not use the ID in the main EVO database as they were not kept in sync.
- DBN0105651, DBN0109722: It was found that the PostAP leg of SIBB transactions were not posting correctly. The application and sproc sp\_bpoGet\_REPOST\_ACCTSyncQueue have been modified to account for the sub document type of SIBB for SINV.
